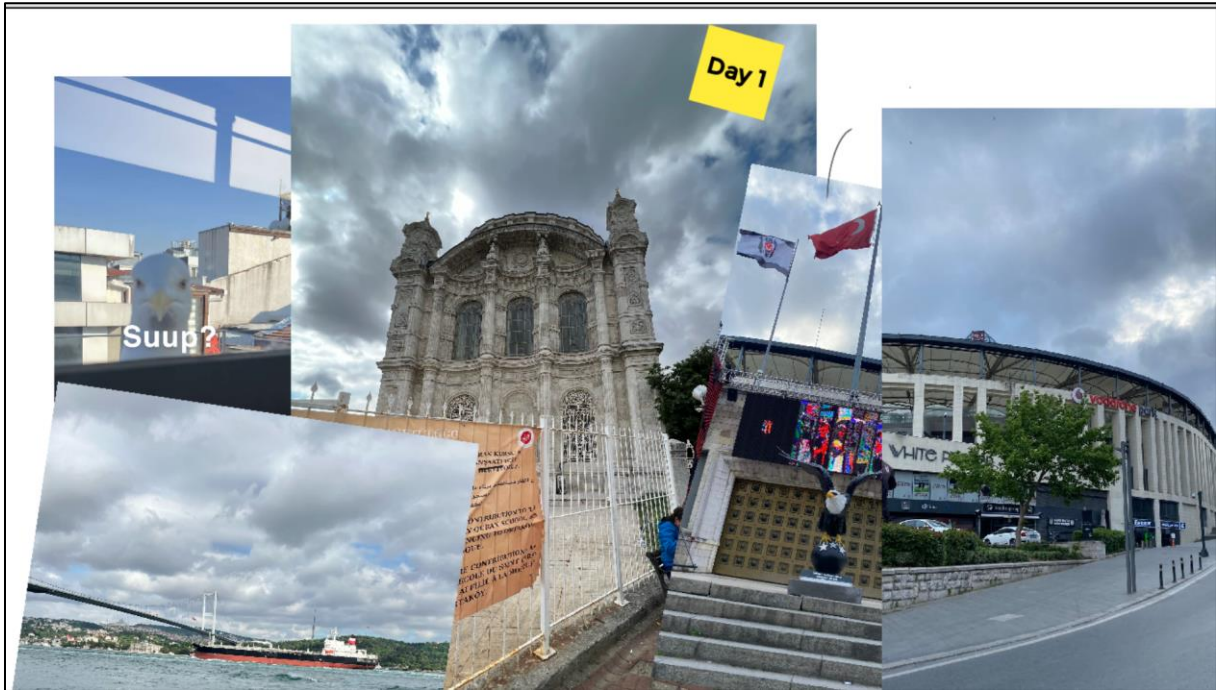

Learning outcomes: Students will enhance their digital literacy and visual documentation skills by using the Jamboard app to capture and describe various project elements. They will develop concise communication and collaborative abilities, working together to create a visually engaging and informative digital representation. Additionally, students will increase their cultural awareness and analytical thinking, effectively managing and reflecting on their project documentation.

A few results from the documentation of the city and the results from the lessons:



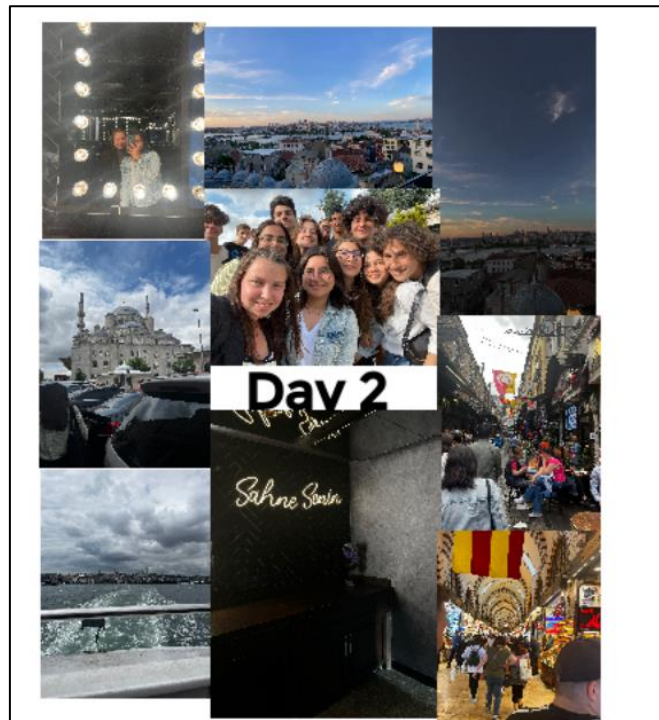


Empathetic people are more able to live by their own ethical standards, without having to do things they know are not acceptable just to fit in.
